

# TO THE 80TH ANNIVERSARY OF ACADEMICIAN ANATOLY IVANOVICH MARTYNOV

---



**Anatoly I. Martynov celebrated his 80th anniversary in October 2017. He is doctor of medical Sciences, Professor, Academician of the Russian Academy of Medical Sciences, Head of the Department of Internal diseases №1 of the medical faculty with a course of echocardiography of the Faculty of Postgraduate Education of the Moscow State University of Medicine and Dentistry named after A.I. Evdokimov (MSUMD), co-chairman of the Eurasian Association of Cardiology, Honored Doctor of Russia, Honored Scientist of the Russian Federation, laureate of the USSR Council of Ministers Prize.**

Anatoly I. Martynov was awarded many medals and awards: the medal "Excellent worker of the healthcare of the USSR", the medal "Veteran of Labor", "The Honorary Badge of the State Order", the Order of the Russian Orthodox Church "Saint Blessed Prince Daniel of Moscow" of 3rd degree, the Order "For Services to the Fatherland" of 2nd degree, the sign "Excellent worker of Healthcare of Bashkortostan" and other orders and medals.

Anatoly Ivanovich was born and raised in Moscow. In 1964 he graduated with honors from the Second Moscow State Medical Institute. The first years of the young doctor and scientist were connected with the department of hospital therapy of the medical faculty (the head of the department was academician P.Ye. Lukomsky): first he studied in residency and then in postgraduate studies. In 1969 Anatoly Ivanovich became an assistant of this department. From 1971 to 1980 he held the post of associate professor of hospital therapy department at the Moscow State Medical Dental University. From 1980 to 1995 he worked in the system of government medicine, first as head of the department of cardiology, and then as chief physician of the Central Clinical Hospital, after which he became the head of the Medical Center of the Presidential Administration. From 1995 to 2001, Anatoly Ivanovich was vice-president of the Russian Academy of Medical Sciences. At the same time, since 1992, A.I. Martynov – head of the Department of Hospital Therapy № 1 of the Medicine Faculty of MSUMD. In 2006 Anatoly Ivanovich became deputy general director for science and new technologies of Medical Center of the Department of Affairs of the Mayor and the Government of Moscow, continuing to combine this work with the position of professor of the department. Under the influence of outstanding doctors and scientists, including Academician P.Ye. Lukomsky, prof. V.P. Pomerantsev, V.G. Popov, I.V. Martynov, V.V. Soloviev, L.L. Orlov, E.I. Zharov and others,

the formation of A.I. Martynov as a doctor and a scientific worker happened. In 1970, Anatoly Ivanovich defended his Ph.D. thesis, which was performed on the basis of two specialties – cardiology and neurology, in which he studied the features of cerebral blood flow in patients with myocardial infarction.

The famous clinician and scientist Anatoly Martynov devoted himself to the study of connective heart dysplasia, painless myocardial ischemia, sleep disorders in arterial hypertension, metabolic effects of antihypertensive therapy, and diastolic heart function. Anatoly Ivanovich, leading specialist in the study of the functional state of the cardiovascular system in patients with chronic heart failure, ischemic heart disease, arterial hypertension, developed a set of measures to monitor patients after heart operations (aorto-coronary shunting, balloon angioplasty, valve replacement) and treatment and rehabilitation of patients after a myocardial infarction, as well as patients with complicated rhythm disturbances and conduction of the heart. He suggested the primary system, the secondary prevention and treatment of cardiovascular diseases

A.I. Martynov is an experienced teacher and great lecturer. His seminars, clinical analysis, lectures and rounds of patients are visited with great interest by students, residents, graduate students, and doctors of basic hospitals. Support and influence of A.I. Martynov contributed to the professional and scientific growth of talented youth: a well-known clinical and scientific school was formed; under his leadership, 9 doctoral and 26 candidate dissertations were defended; the staff of the department took part in more than 10 international and Russian multicenter clinical trials.

A.I. Martynov, being the co-chairman of the Eurasian Association of Cardiologists, carries out a huge work on maintaining contacts with leading cardiologists of near and far abroad. Anatoly Ivanovich is the author of almost 400 publications, 18 monographs, manuals, books, textbooks and reference books. A.I. Martynov is one of three editors and author of several sections on cardiology in the two-volume book "Internal Diseases" (2004, 2005, 2008, 2012), which is recognized as the best textbook on therapy for medical universities. Anatoly Ivanovich is a member of the editorial boards of the journals "Medicine of critical states", "Rational pharmacotherapy in cardiology", "Cardiovascular

therapy and prevention", "Arterial hypertension", "The older generation", "Successes in gerontology".

Openness, goodwill, decency, energy, conviction, a deep vision of problems are those personal qualities of A.I. Martynov, which served as the foundation of his scientific formation.
